2. <u>INFORMATION/DISCUSSION</u>

Title: Finance & Budget Information Session

This item is to give Senators and prospective Interns more information on the DASB Finance Committee and the DASB Budget. Topics include: Special Allocations fund and requests, line item transfer requests, budget transfer requests, DASB's sources of revenue, the budget system, the differences between Fund 41 and Fund 46, the processes and documents involved in the budget deliberations, other common terms used in the committee, and ongoing projects for the committee.

Presenter: Grace Lim, Lisa Kirk, Dennis Shannakian

Time: 30 minutes

- Grace presented detailed information about the DASB Finance Committee and DASB Budget. Topics she spoke about include Fund 41, Fund 46, DASB sources of revenue, the different types of budget requests, the Finance Committee timeline, the budget rubric, and ongoing projects.
- Lisa gave an overview of the 2019-2020 actuals and 2020-2021 budget for the two main sources of revenue. She shared De Anza's enrollment is flat. She also shared information about the fiscal year, the balanced budget, special allocations funding, a comparison between actuals and estimates, and updates about flea market revenue.

- Jeffrey asked what is the opt out rate of students regarding the Student Representation Fee.
 - Lisa answered most students pay the fee
 - o Hyon Chu asked if it shows if students can opt out.
 - o Lisa answered no, only if the student actually clicks on the details of the fee page.
- Jeffrey asked if international student enrollment went down.
 - Lisa responded she only knows De Anza head count, but you can find that information on the Institutional Research website for De Anza. She shared enrollment overall is only down 29 students.
- Hyon Chu suggested possibly inviting Mallory Newell to discuss student numbers.
 - o Discussion occurred regarding student enrollment statistics
- Lisa went over and explained a Fund 41 spreadsheet. She explained in detail past numbers and explained how she estimates budgets. She also gave more information about Flea Market estimates.
- Hyon Chu mentioned they just hired a TEA person named Mohamed and he will be working on an online Flea Market.
- Lisa provided more explanation regarding past budgets and estimates.
 - o Grace asked how much is to be allocated for this year.
 - Lisa responded she doesn't have the 2021-2022 estimate yet, but she expects it to be the same as the current budget.
- Britney asked what would happen to our allocations if the Flea Market doesn't bring in any revenue.
 - Lisa explained it would affect the overall actual revenue number, but there are still other sources of income meaning there will still be money to allocate.
- Hyon Chu suggested reaching out to everyone who received funds for this year to figure out whether or not they will be using their funds.
- Anthony asked if it is safe to assume that allocations will not be affected by loss of Flea Market revenue because most fund allocations are not being used.
 - o Lisa explained they can only estimate because there are a lot of unknowns.
- Lisa explained the Special Allocations process.
- Huy asked if there is information regarding the student status of enrollment.
 - o Lisa mentioned enrollment is only down 29 students.
 - o Huy shared maybe the reason why enrollment is not down is because many students are doing dual enrollment because of the online transition.
